Writing comments on student papers is something of an art: it requires a little thought and practice for the comments to be effective--that is, both read and attended to. The following recommendations about writing comments were developed for students in writing and literature classes; however, with a little adjustment, they can be applied to any writing assignment.

Recommendations for Writing Comments on Student Papers

Aug 4, 2015 - Are you always writing "Good!" on your student's papers? Print these and hang them by your desk for some "Out of this world" comments. You'll never run out of something great to say about their hard work.

Tell students upfront what you will be looking for in their papers. Then keep this focus in mind when formulating comments on each paper. If you're concentrating on argument, provide direct feedback on each student's argument. For example: "Your argument is strong, clearly stated, and supported by ample evidence."

Guidelines for providing feedback to assignments

Keep your tone positive. By default, many students misunderstand the purpose of feedback and see it as judgment instead of enabling learning. Keep this in mind and go out of your way to be supportive and positive. Judgmental or critical comments can undermine a student's motivation and impede the learning process.

Give Your Students Better Writing Feedback
