For natural gas fire pits, there is a required minimum clearance of 10 feet. Fires contained in a portable pit or barbecue must remain at least 15 feet away from any structure or flammable materials. Although these are the official backyard fire pit laws, we suggest you put as much distance between the fire and its surroundings as possible.

Open burning is allowed from mid winter to early spring across most of Massachusetts. It is prohibited in 22 densely built and populated cities and towns. See below for a list. If open burning is allowed in your community, contact your local fire department to obtain an open burning permit in advance.

The fire pit can be no closer than 15 feet to any structure, combustible material, property line, deck, etc. Only firewood, limbs, and wood chips may be burned in the fire pit. The fire pit can be no larger than 36 inches in diameter. The flames can be no higher than 2 feet.

Only burn seasoned, dry wood, which burns hotter and cleaner. Use a moisture meter to check firewood; moisture content is best at about 20 percent. Cover stacked wood, but allow good air flow so it can dry. Never burn wood during air quality alert days, when air pollution is already higher.

Backyard Recreational Fires | Burn Wise | US EPA

The purpose of these rules and regulations is to clarify and interpret the exception to the general prohibition on open burning that allows "the burning of fuels for legitimate campfire, recreational and cooking purposes," unless such activities cause air pollution, as provided in 35 IAC Sec. 237.120(e) and incorporated by reference in Section 1 1-4-740 of the Code, with the intention of protecting people from air pollution. 2.0 Legitimate Campfire, Recreational, and Cooking Activities.

A Phillipsburg ordinance, for example, requires all outdoor fires to burn at least 10 feet from any structure on a property. This includes detached garages and utility sheds. Going further, the Township of Moorestown specifies that open pit fires must also be 10 feet from any combustible landscapes.

There's no need for a blazing bonfire, and the bigger the fire, the greater the potential for disaster. First things first, your fire pit should be at least 10 feet away from any structure or combustible surface. Before lighting an outdoor fire, check the weather forecast. Avoid windy conditions that can blow embers.

Campfires, Bonfires, Fire Pits, Chimineas and Other Similar Devices. The burning of wood in a campfire, bonfire, chiminea or other similar devices is prohibited if the burning is conducted so that it creates a nuisance for neighbors or it is in violation of any restrictions imposed on such burning by your local municipality.

Wetter wood will burn slower, but you don't want it too wet or it won't catch fire. Wet wood will smoke way more than dry wood. If you have extra firewood, keep it stacked upwind of your fire, so that a sudden breeze won't light all the rest of your wood on fire. Keep the fire small so it stays under control.

Campfires (U.S. National Park Service)

Gatherings, picnics and parties are not allowed. Visitors will be asked to leave if there are too many people at the park, beach or on trails to allow for the required physical distance. Stay Clean: Be prepared. Bring soap/sanitizer and pack out all trash.

For conditionally allowed private residential, commercial, or industrial property burning of dead and dry weeds, burn hours are from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. There are no time restrictions on permanently installed outdoor fireplaces, barbeque pits, and portable fireplaces or chimineas.

Outdoor Open Burning — City of Albuquerque

Open burning requirements: Maintain a means to extinguish the fire at all times while burning. Use a non-combustible container with a ventilated mesh covering containing openings no greater than .25 inches. Burn only between the hours of 10 a.m. and 3 p.m.

Even though portable fire pits and chimineas are fashionable and widely offered for sale in garden centers and home stores, open burning of wood (or any products other than propane, natural gas, or charcoal briquettes) is outlawed in Denver without permits from the Denver Department of Environmental Health and the Fire Prevention and Investigation Division.

Open Fire Pits There is no type of special permit required in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts for the use of outdoor fire pits on private property however; there are some simple rules to follow such as: 1. Keep the fire small and manageable (less than 3' in diameter).

Open Fire Pits/Chimneys - Groveland Fire Rescue Department

Apartment Buildings may require twenty five (25) feet. Fire Pits cannot be used during "Air Quality Alert" days. Any other "Open Burning" (trash, brush, etc) must be approved by the Division of Fire, Fire Prevention Bureau and must have a permit. If there are ANY complaints from neighbors, immediate extinguishment must be done.
